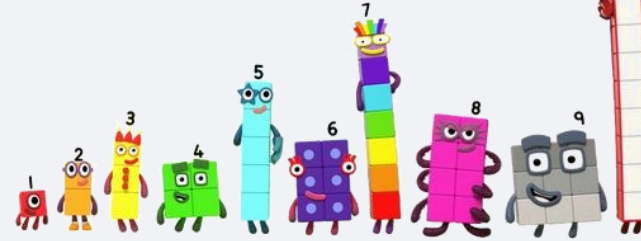
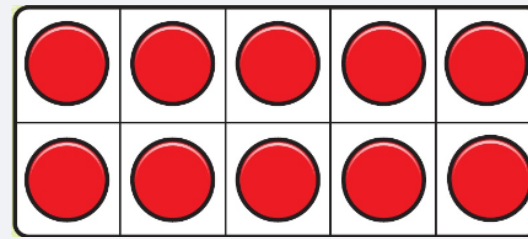


Sticky Knowledge...

- In the past, people enjoyed building sandcastles. People still enjoy doing this when they visit the seaside now.



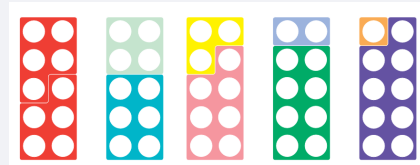
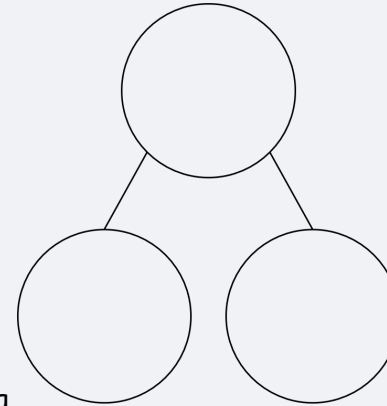
